

The Graduate Art Show - Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility

- 1.1. The Graduate Art Show is open to all 2023-2024 graduates with a BA or MA in Art
- 1.2. Each participant may submit one piece of artwork for consideration.
- 1.3. Submissions are accepted in various mediums including painting, sculpture, mixed media, and digital art.

2. Submission Guidelines

- 2.1. All submissions must be made through our official website: thegraduateartshow.global.
- 2.2. Submissions must include a JPG image of the artwork and the submission form filled.
- 2.3. The submission deadline is 23 August 2024. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- 2.4. The submitted artwork must be the original creation of the participant.

3. Selection Process

- 3.1. The selection panel, comprising industry professionals, will review all submissions.
- 3.2. Selected artists will be announced on 19 September 2024.
- 3.3. Decisions made by the selection panel are final and not subject to appeal.

4. Exhibition and Sale

- 4.1. By submitting, participants agree to have their artwork displayed at the Woolff Gallery and Vanner Gallery during the specified dates.
- 4.2. Participants consent to the potential sale of their artwork to interested buyers during the exhibition.
- 4.3. Artists will receive 50% of the sale price if their artwork is sold during the exhibition period. The remaining 50% will be retained by the galleries as commission (before VAT).
- 4.4. Unsold artworks will be collected by the artists after the conclusion of the exhibitions.
- 4.5 The galleries carry insurance for artworks displayed during the exhibition period.

5. Intellectual Property

- 5.1. Participants retain ownership of their submitted artworks.
- 5.2. By submitting, artists grant The Graduate Art Show the right to use images of their work for promotional purposes across various media.

6. General Conditions

- 6.1. The Graduate Art Show reserves the right to amend these T&Cs at any time.
- 6.2. Participants are responsible for the delivery and collection of their artwork to and from the exhibition venues.
- 6.3. The Graduate Art Show is not responsible for any damage or loss of artworks during the submission process or prior to the gallery's insurance coverage.
- 6.4. Participation in The Graduate Art Show constitutes full and unconditional agreement to these T&Cs.
